

Why should I consider taking a CLEP exam?

Madonna University is pleased to recognize the [Advanced Placement \(AP\)](#) programs and exams, which is a form of credit-by-exam, which recognizes students' academic excellence and achievement. To get college credit, students must have taken an AP course in high school, registered and sat for the respective AP exam, and received the appropriate credit-granting score (see below). To receive AP equivalency credit at Madonna University, an official transcript from College Board is required.

The chart below indicates the amount of credit awarded at Madonna University for AP tests with scores of four or higher.
