- OCICU: Online Consortium of Independent Colleges and Universities
- FOA: Felician Online Alliance
- DACHEC: Detroit Area Catholic Higher Education Consortium

When should an advisor consider recommending a consortium course to a student?

- If the student needs a course to move along in their plan of study, but it is not offered at MU during that semester
- If the student is looking to take an independent study that could be satisfied by an FOA course
- If the student is looking to take a course that we don't offer at MU

How do MU students register for consortium courses?
