



What is OCICU?

OCICU is the Online Consortium of Independent Colleges and Universities (OCICU). As a member institution, it gives our students the opportunity to take online courses through other OCICU member institutions.

OCICU FAQs

- Students can utilize their financial aid to take OCICU courses
- OCICU offers courses that are <u>full sixteen week semesters and also eight week offerings</u> during the first and second half of each semester as well.
- OCICU courses <u>can be used to retake a course that has already been completed at MU</u> with an unsatisfactory grade.
- Students utilizing an Employee Tuition Waiver and taking OCICU courses should check with the Enrollment Center to determine potential fees with utilizing this consortium.

When to consider recommending an OCICU course:

- If the student needs a course to move along in their plan of study, but it is not offered at MU during that semester
- If the student is looking to take an independent study that could be satisfied by an OCICU course
- If the student is looking to take a course that we don't offer at MU

How do MU students register for OCICU courses?

- Students should schedule an appointment with their Retention Specialist to discuss their options and get registered
