 minimum total of 120 semester hours needed for a first Bachelor degree. Courses must be approved for
 transfer, non-remedial and have a grade above a 2.0 ("C") or higher. Students pursuing a course of study
 under an existing articulation agreement should contact Madonna University's Articulation Specialist,
 cdriscoll@madonna.edu in the Office of the Registrar to discuss approved and maximum credit
 allowances.
