

Study Abroad Assistance Award Terms and Conditions

Study Abroad Assistance Award

Need-based academic award for part-time or full-time undergraduate students, who exhibit financial need as determined by the FAFSA, and desire to enroll in study abroad related courses and engage in an international educational experience. Students must apply by the prescribed deadline and adhere to these terms and conditions to be eligible.

- 1. The scholarship is offered to an on-campus undergraduate student who is:
 - a. Currently enrolled at Madonna University;
 - b. Enrolled either part-time or full-time; and
 - c. Pursuing an undergraduate degree;
- 2. The scholarship requires a separate scholarship application. To apply, complete the application and follow the instructions provided by the Office of Study Abroad.
- 3. The Office for Study Abroad will notify students if they have been selected. Scholarship awards are administered by the Office of Financial Aid.
- 4. The scholarship is a non-renewable, single payment, to the student's account during the semester in which a credit-bearing study abroad course is to commence.
- 5. The scholarship recipient must maintain satisfactory academic progress, good social standing, and continuous enrollment as an undergraduate student, and must maintain enrollment in an appropriate credit-bearing study abroad course.
- 6. The scholarship can only be used toward the payment of costs incurred on the Livonia campus of Madonna University. The scholarship is not applicable or transferable to any other institution, college, or university.
- 7. If a student must withdraw during the semester and tuition is partially refunded, the scholarship will also be adjusted.
- 8. The scholarship may be reduced if a student receives other grants, scholarships, or benefits restricted to tuition from outside agencies or third-party entities, or if a student's total federal, state, and other institutional awards would exceed the tuition/cost of attendance.
- 9. The award is based on financial need and other criteria. Consequently, it could be adjusted or rescinded if the student's financial need changes due to the receipt of other institutional awards including, but not limited to, the Academic Housing Award, Alumni Legacy Scholarship, Athletic Scholarship, BLG Scholarship, Catholic High School Scholarship, Community Engagement Scholarship, Crusader Assistance Award, DECA Scholarship, Music Scholarship and/or Performing Arts Scholarship.
- 10. The scholarship offer is designated in a dollar amount (rather than a percentage).
- 11. The scholarship offer must be accepted by the deadline or funds may expire or be offered to other students. Late applications may not receive full consideration, regardless of eligibility.
