- 7) Assesses transfer substitutions and equivalencies for WRT 1000, 1010, and 1020.
- 8) Completes assigned teaching load in first year composition courses.
- 9) Represents the Composition Program on University committees.
- 10) Develops presentations for composition and rhetoric conferences.
- 11) Conducts office hours for students, faculty, and staff.
- 12) Responds to student inquiries and/or complaints related to the composition program.
- 13) Conducts faculty performance reviews for composition faculty.
- 14) Performs other faculty duties as assigned and per the Faculty Handbook.
